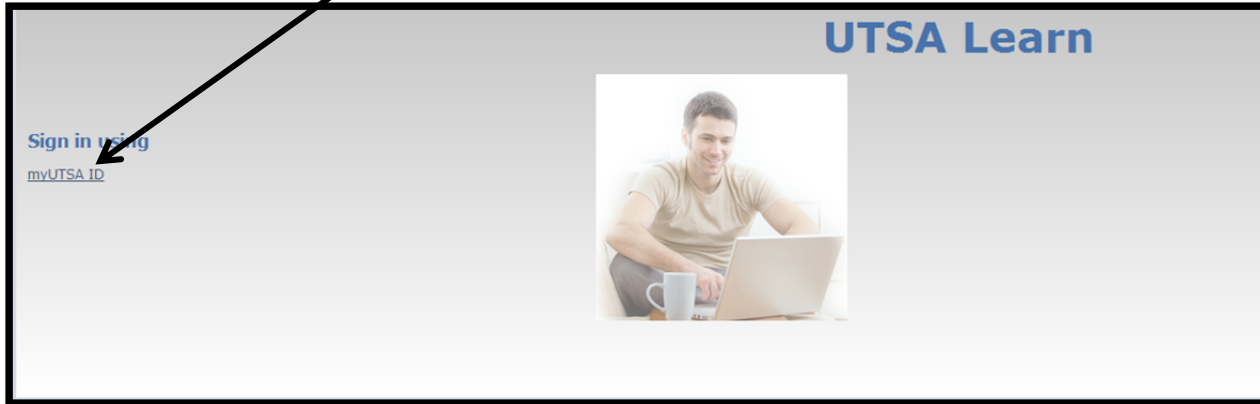
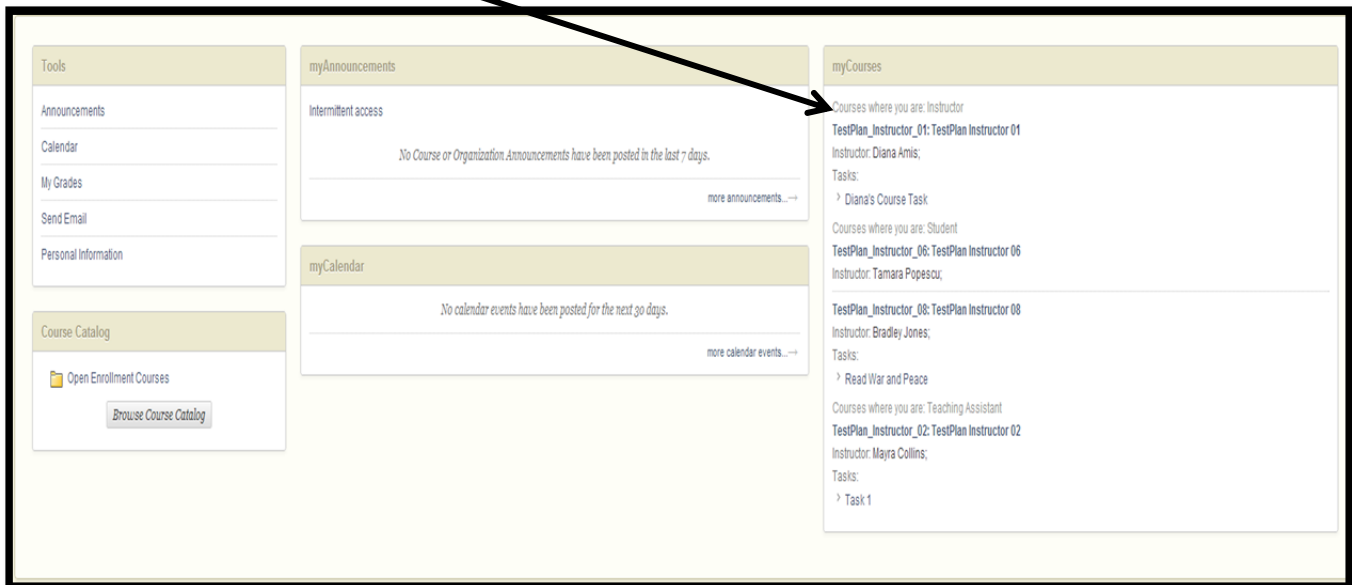


How to Link a Video/Audio File from inside Your Learn Course from the UTSA Helix Media Library

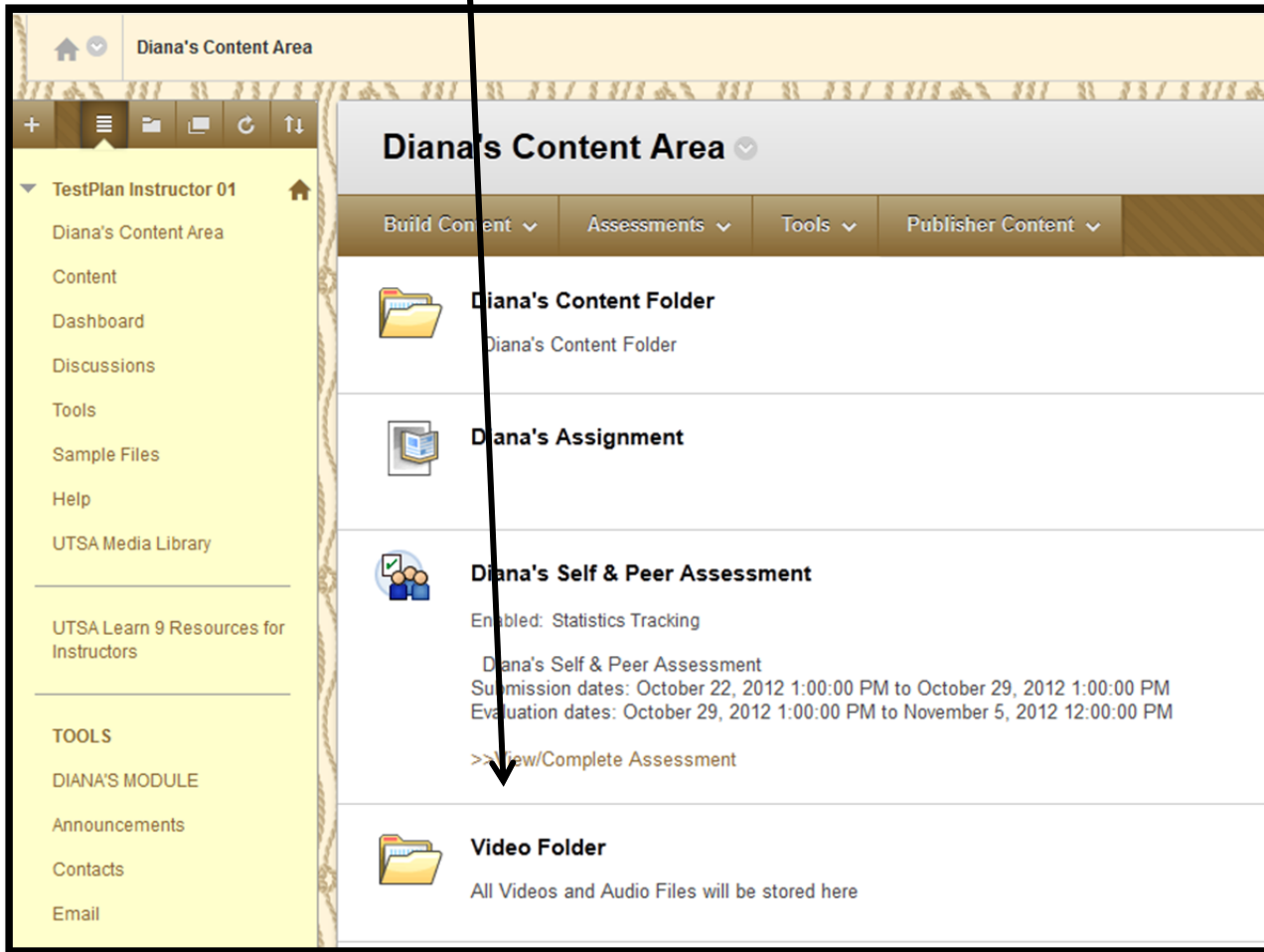
1. **Login to Blackboard Learn** using your myUTSA ID and your Network Password



2. **Click on the course** you want the Video/Audio file to be in

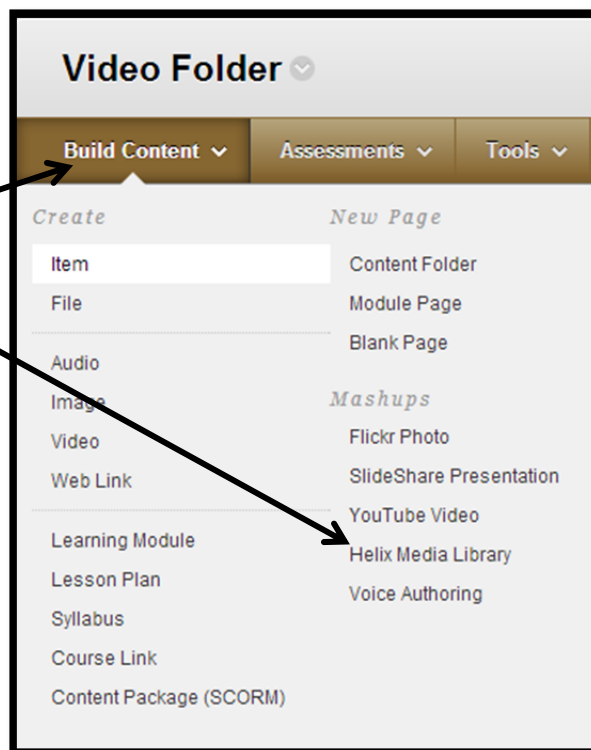


3. You can create a Specific Folder for your Video and Audio Files
(**NOTE:** This step is not needed to proceed and can be skipped)



4. From either your Home Page or a folder you created in the Content Area, to link a Video/Audio File from the UTSA Helix Media Library you need to:

- a. Click on **Build Content**
- b. Select **Helix Media Library** from the list

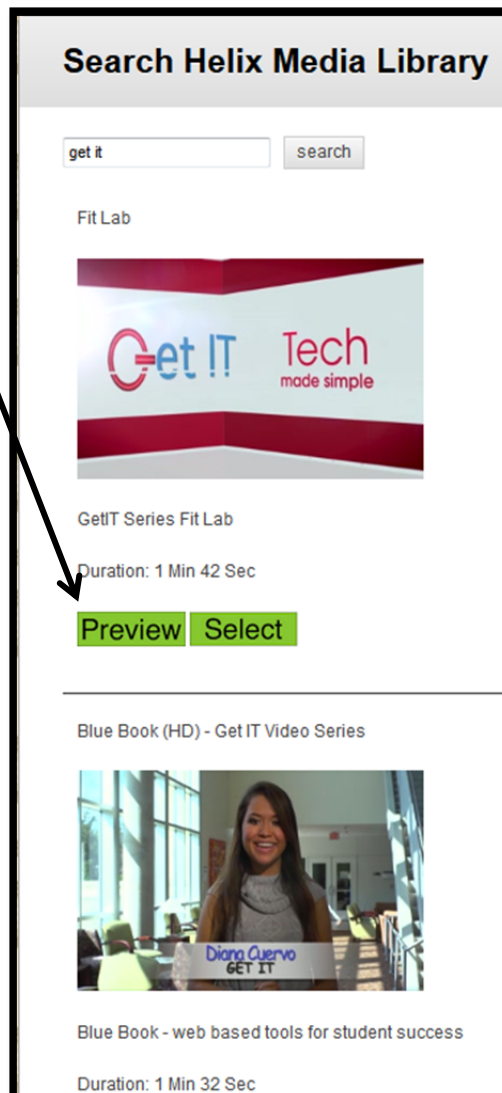


5. A **Search Box** will appear, **type in your criteria** and click on **Search**



6. You will then receive a list of video/audio files that meet your criteria

You can either Preview or go ahead and Select the video you need just by clicking on the **Preview or Select** buttons provided



7. Your video is now available to your students.
To view the video click on the **Click to View** link
